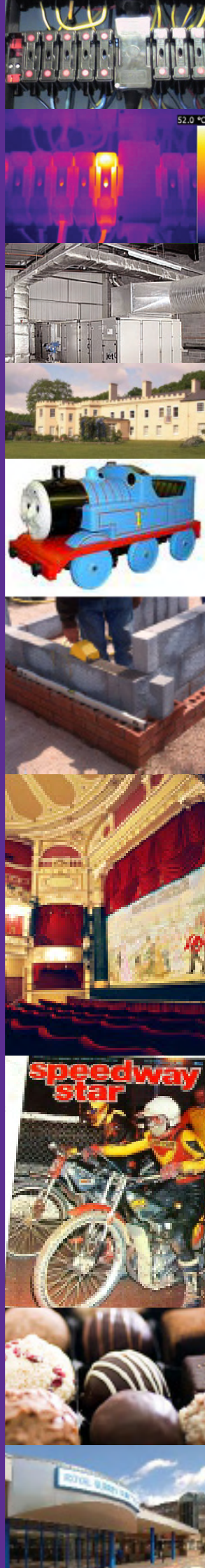

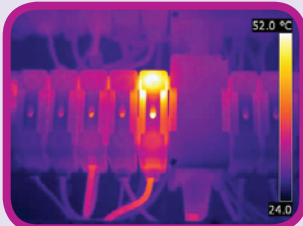

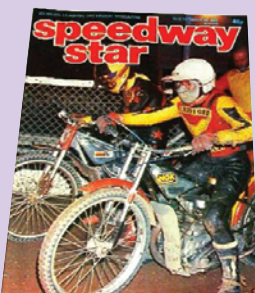
• **Exhausting work**

When some of the air conditioning at the Avisford Park Hilton Hotel failed it was decided the old ozone depleting R22 gas equipment would be replaced with ten modern Fujitsu inverter driven heat pump units containing 410A gas refrigerant. Not only are these units more efficient and considerably cheaper to run, they are also considered to be 'greener' units. The installation of the ten replacement units was staggered to minimise disruption to the hotels clients, with some work taking place out of hours. The internal units were concealed by our own carpenters to provide an aesthetically pleasing finish. Any air conditioning equipment containing R22 gas should be considered for immediate replacement - it may just help to save the world.....please call if you require any further information.

Gray Process Heaters our heater manufacturing division has had another busy year. New heaters have been dispatched throughout the UK and exported to various European Countries as well. The heater units have many different uses for process, industrial and commercial applications, and are available from 29 KW upto 1,780 KW, they can be used with oil, LPG, gas, solid fuel or dual fuel. Two replacement dual fuel heaters were recently sent to a Bristol train station, we are not sure if it was for the benefit of the staff or for the trains - look out for news in the next saga of Thomas the Tank Engine.

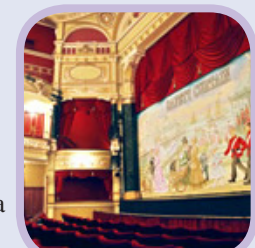


• **'Drama Queens'**
