When some of the air conditioning at the Avisford Park Hilton Hotel failed it was decided the old ozone depleting R22 gas equipment would be replaced with ten modern Fujitsu inverter driven heat pump units containing 410A gas refrigerant. Not only are these units more efficient and considerably cheaper to run, they are also considered to be 'greener' units. The installation of the ten replacement units was staggered to minimise disruption to the hotels clients, with some work taking place out of hours. The internal units were concealed by our own carpenters to provide an aesthetically pleasing finish.

European Countries as well. The heater units have many different uses for process, industrial and commercial applications, and are available from 29 KW upto 1,780 KW, they can be used with oil, LPG, gas, solid fuel or dual fuel.
