• 'Doctors keep their cool'





With the criteria of keeping the floor space clear and safe for the child care groups (as well as keeping them warm) Saunders Specialised Services designed and installed a Radiant Heating system for Haywards Heath Church Hall using six ceiling mounted Alfaheat AS24 heaters all wired centrally to a flexible automatic control system.

The heaters provide a fast heat up time and give the occupants a comfortable and energy efficient heating system using Scandinavian technology.



The installation took place in mid 2006 and considered the building aesthetics and occupant demands. The Daikin systems provide climate control with integral photocatalytic deodorising air filters providing high standards of thermal comfort to a demanding facility.

From now on, the Doctors and patients of Arundel will at least keep their cool during the summer.
